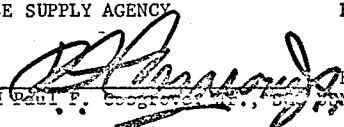
VII. AUTHORITY

This agreement is entered into under the authority of the Economy Act approved June 30, 1932, as amended 31 USC 686.

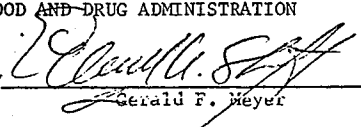
