MEMORANDUM FOR MEMBERS OF THE AD HOC INTERAGENCY
MEDICAL AND NONPERISHABLE SUBSISTENCE
SUPPLY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

SUBJECT: Nonperishable Subsistence, DOD/VA
Plan of Action dated January 21, 1975

The DOD/VA Task Force developed and presented subject plan which describes the NPS project in a broad sense. The report is, therefore, very useful, especially for providing an understanding of the general information.

The next step is to develop a specific work plan. The following is proposed as the first phase of the work plan.

(*)1. Limit the scope to:

- a. Military hospitals
- b. Civil agency hospitals
- c. All other civil agency users for intra-government programs (i.e., school lunch programs and programs related to P.L. 480, etc.)

2. Within this scope, determine the answers to the following questions:

- a. What items are being purchased?
- b. From what sources are items being acquired?
- c. Who is purchasing the items?
- d. For which users are items being purchased?

Please review the above and submit your comments to me by February 14, 1975.
