Following lunch, the Committee reconvened, and although this portion of the meeting was chaired by L. Sorett, Admiral Smith participated.

- 3. <u>DOD/VA Progress Report on NPS</u>. There had been preliminary discussions between DOD and VA. No formal report was made. Instead, at our next meeting, we shall receive a work plan developed jointly by Mr. Daniel J. Shaunnessy of VA, and Mr. Spellman of DPSC.
- 4. Progress Report by Colonel Trimble in the Categorization of Medical Items. The report by Col. Trimble representing the work of the Task Group #1 will undoubtedly prove to be a breakthrough conceptually in the development of a single system whereby the strengths of DOD and VA can be utilized within a single management system. A report will be mailed by the Task Group to the Committee by January 10, which will outline in detail this concept. The essential points are:
- (a) Procurement data acquisition system for items which are purchased from other than central sources in significant volume;
 - (b) A Government-wide item entry system;
- (c) A Government-wide determination of unequitable supply;
- (d) Items to be managed on stock basis or on a nonstock basis; and
