H.R. 595

TITLE 2, D.C. CODE

No comparable provisions.

Sec. 15—authorizes and provides that :

- (1) all functions hereunder may be delegated to the present Board of Optometry, or to any officer or employee of the District government, upon such terms and conditions as may be desirable or necessary.
- (2) licenses currently in effect shall remain in effect until the newly declared renewal date, unless sooner revoked or suspended.
- (3) amends § 11-742, D.C. Code so as to rest jurisdiction in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals to review orders and decisions denying, suspending, revoking, or failing to renew or reinstate any license to practice optometry.
- (4) sets the effective date of the Act (90 days after its enactment).
