MORALE AND WELFARE

Principal service area of Kaiserslautern is Vogelweh—a huge housing and shopping complex with a real estate value of more than \$48,000,000. Vogelweh is situated two miles west of the city limits on Parisher Strasse. From the autobahn, Vogelweh is reached directly by exiting at the Kaiserslautern Mitte exit.

In 1951, during a period referred to by the Germans as an "economic miracle", workers labored night and day to build this community on the site of a bird refuge. Vogelweh is now known widely as "Little America" because it has the largest congregation of U.S. personnel in Europe.

Vogelweh, Mannheimer Str., Blutacker and Flieger Str., Housing Areas contain a total of 1871 family units, the larger share of the USAACOM's Palatinate District's family housing units; a high school, junior high and two elementary schools; a chapel; NCO and EM clubs; the Officers and Civilians Open Mess; Service Club; and all exchange, postal and banking facilities. The Post Exchange is one of the largest in Europe; the automotive repair garage is the largest, and the commissary is second only to Frankfurt in sales volume.
