(b) The Contractor shall further indicate on each Form submitted under this contract, the price of United States Government-furnished Materiel (GFM) that is included in each line item covered by the respective Form.

(c) The Contractor shall include in each of its subcontracts under which deliveries may be made directly to the United States Government, a provision whereby such subcontractor agrees to prepare and distribute the Form and to enter thereon the price of all GFM included in items so delivered to the United States Government. The price of GFM will be made available to the contractor or subcontractor by the United States Government, as the case may be. No delivery shall be delayed by reason of the failure of the United States Government to furnish such prices to the contractor or subcontractor. The contractor shall require each subcontractor to include a similar provision in its subcontracts.

Clause 39. OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT (JAN. 1961)

This contract is renewable, at the option of the United States Government, by the Contracting Officer giving written notices of renewal to the Contractor within the period specified in the Schedule; provided, that the Contracting Officer shall have given preliminary notice of the United States Government's intention to renew at least sixty (60) days before this contract is to expire. (Such a preliminary notice will not be deemed to commit the United States Government to renewals). If the United States Government exercises this option for renewals, the contract as renewed shall be deemed to include this option provision. However, the total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed two (2) years.
