SEC. 202. (a) No person may attach or garnish wages
or salary due an employee, or pursue in any court any similar
legal or equitable remedy which has the effect of stopping
or diverting the payment of wages or salary due an employee.
(b) Whoever violates subsection (a) of this section
shall be fined not more than \$1,000, or imprisoned not more
than one year, or both.
TITLE III—COMMISSION ON CONSUMER FINANCE
SEC. 301. ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established a bi-
partisan National Commission on Consumer Finance (re-
ferred to in this title as the "Commission").
SEC. 302. MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION.—(a)
The Commission shall be composed of nine members, of
whom—
(1) three are Members of the Senate appointed
by the President of the Senate;
(2) three are Members of the House of Representa-
tives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Repre-
sentatives; and
(3) three are persons not employed in a full-time
capacity by the United States appointed by the Presi-
dent, one of whom he shall designate as Chairman.
(b) A vacancy in the Commission does not affect its
powers and may be filled in the same manner as the original
appointment.
