

Mr. ADAMS. I guess that is a reason for the committee to speak.

Mr. BROWN. By the acquiescence of the committee we would permit that to happen if that is the sequence of events.

Mr. ADAMS. Then I guess the only recourse the public interest would have would be the courts.

Mr. BROWN. Thank you.

Mr. MACDONALD. Thank you very much, gentlemen.
