have a problem of trying to control that if it became a problem which so far as I know it has not.

Mr. Macdonald. Thank you very much, Mr. Wright, on behalf of the committee for coming here and giving us a lucid and well-thoughtout presentation.

Mr. Wright. I appreciate your courtesy and interest.

If there is any more information desired, we will be delighted to supply it. We have been working on this a long time. We have worked hard. We hope we will get a chance to let the public decide whether it is a proper service.

Mr. Macdonald. Thank you very much.

The hearing is adjourned until 10 a.m. in the morning in this room. (Whereupon, at 12:15 p.m. the subcommittee adjourned, to reconvene at 10 a.m., Thursday, October 12, 1967.)
