hibit the manufacture of cloth buttons. The law declared the making

of cloth buttons a penal offense.

It remained in the statute of Virginia from 1683 to 1721. I hope, Mr. Chairman, that you and members of the subcommittee will agree that we should not turn back the clock to the year 1683.

Thank you, Mr. Chairman, for your patience.

Mr. Macdonald. Thank you very much for a very interesting presentation. As a matter of fact, I think that historians are probably right and cloth buttons are probably coming back.

Mr. SAGALL. Thank you.

Mr. Macdonald. With this the hearing will have to be adjourned

until Monday morning at 10 a.m.
