

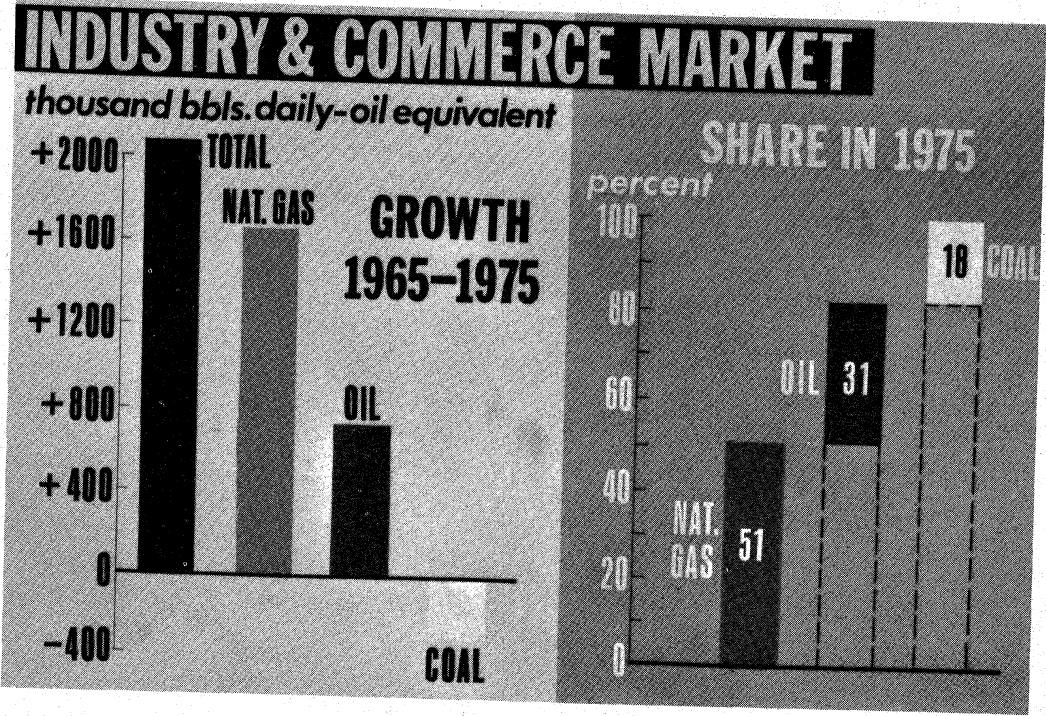

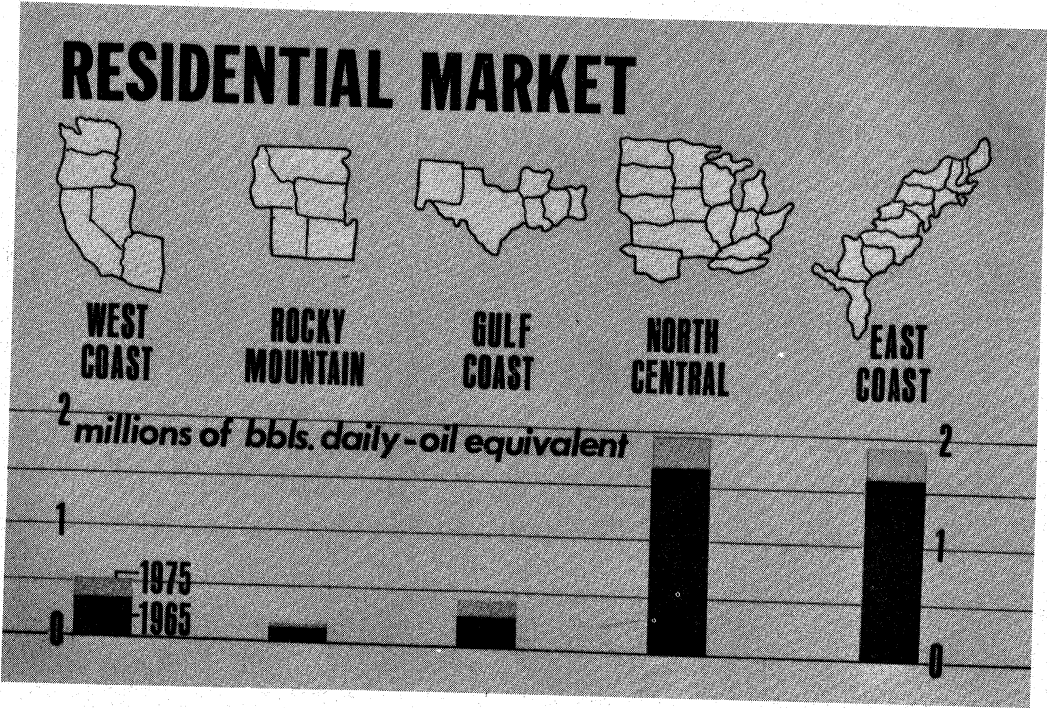

In the north-central-region market, the growth for natural gas exceeds the total market expansion, again coming at the expense of coal. Of course, we do have a direct competition between natural gas and oil, because it is quite obvious that, without the availability of gas, oil alone would be equally capable of displacing coal. Down in the gulf coast area, gas, again, will get the major share of the market growth as shown on chart 36.
