Senator HANSEN. One further question. I appreciate that I have taken a long time, but I think what you have said is of such importance that we ought not to pass over it hurriedly.

We are not the only nation in the world with oil shale; isn't that true?

Mr. CAMERON. That is correct.

Senator HANSEN. What other country has significant oil shale deposits?

Mr. CAMERON. Brazil probably has the second largest, but both the Soviet Union and Estonia and mainland China in Manchuria have deposits that are being produced commercially.

Senator HANSEN. You say they are being produced commercially?

Mr. CAMERON. Yes, sir.

Senator HANSEN. Is the Soviet Union actually producing oil?

Mr. CAMERON. Yes, sir; they are producing both oil and gas and chemicals. I might add for your information, Senator, that there will be a technical meeting in the Soviet Union sponsored by the United Nations, an oil shale meeting, next August, in which the broad spectrum of technological papers would be given on oil shale. This may be our first opportunity to observe firsthand some of the Soviet developments in this area.

Senator HANSEN. Well, that is certainly very interesting.

Let me compliment you again on a very excellent and comprehensive statement, Mr. Cameron.
