Mr. BARING, from the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs, submitted the following

REPORT

[To accompany H.R. 12121]

The Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs, to whom was referred the bill (H.R. 12121) to amend the Act of September 9, 1964 (78 Stat. 983), establishing the Public Land Law Review Commission, and for other purposes, having considered the same, report favorably thereon with an amendment and recommend that the bill as amended do pass.

The amendment is as follows:

Amend the title so as to read:

A bill to amend the Act of September 19, 1964 (78 Stat. 983) establishing the Public Land Law Review Commission, and for other purposes.

PURPOSE

The two principal purposes of H.R. 12121 are (1) to extend the life of the Public Land Law Review Commission by 1½ years and (2) to increase the amount authorized to be appropriated to finance the Commission's work by \$3,390,000.

H.R. 12121 was introduced by Representative Aspinall after receipt of a communication from the Commission requesting that this be done.

BACKGROUND

The Public Land Law Review Commission was established for the express purpose of making a comprehensive review of all policies applicable to the use, management, and disposition of the public lands of the United States. In reporting the bill (H.R. 8070, 88th Cong.)
