Mr. Corman. Yes, sir; I yield.

Mr. Patman. Our hearings will resume next Monday, November 6. We will continue with Mr. Hayes and James R. Walsh, Jr. The subpenas are in full force and effect until you and Mr. Walsh are excused by the chairman as a witness before the committee. Hence, we will expect you to bring with you the records described in the subpenas, and particularly those records that you have promised to present.

Mr. Hayes. Yes, sir.

Mr. PATMAN. Following Mr. Walsh's testimony next week, the witness will be Dr. Michael Saxon. He is the doctor you referred to a while ago as here; isn't he?

Mr. HAYES. Right.

Mr. Patman. And Messrs. George Schuyler and J. Alton Lauren, trustee of ABC, and Richard Stephenson, trustee of ABC.

Then on November 13 and 14, we expect to have Secretary Fowler and Commissioner Cohen as witnesses, and we will expect you and Mr. Walsh to be here next Monday, sir.

Mr. Hayes. We will be here. Mr. Patman. With the records.

Mr. Hayes. Yes.

Mr. Patman. And without objection the committee will stand in recess until 10 o'clock next Monday here in this room.

Mr. Morron. Mr. Chairman, I yield the balance of my time.
