Mr. HAYES. It would include the same material that we left with

Mr. Patman. What about the \$4,200 course? Would it include that? Mr. Hayes. The whole thing.
Mr. Patman. The whole \$10,500 package.
Mr. Hayes. The entire educational program.

Mr. Patman. And that is everything. That is educational.
Mr. Hayes. Yes, sir.
Mr. Patman. That is what it is.
Mr. Hayes. That is right.

Mr. PATMAN. The whole thing?

Mr. HAYES. Yes.

Mr. PATMAN. Mr. Morton, sit down here just a minute. I don't think we will be able to meet this afternoon because it takes unanimous consent of the House, and the House is not in a good mood. I would anticipate objection, so we will not undertake it. But we would like to have you, Mr. Hayes and Mr. Walsh, both back back tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock, so without objection we will stand in recess until tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock here in this room.
