## FOUNDATION REVIEW, LIMITATIONS AND ALTERATIONS

The organizational structural chart and the economic flow chart would best be used at this point to conduct this review. These should be prepared as exhibits and not merely used on a blackboard. At this point, each of the members should be reminded that he or she will be wearing several hats simultaneously and that the duties and powers of each of the positions represented by these hats should be be clearly understood. For example, one person might be a director of the foundation, president of the foundation, and executive director of the foundation. Each of these offices has different rights and duties. The details of this particular part of the program should be carefully developed with consideration for time and motive.
