

(b) The public sphere - Your corporate foundation, however, and any other business entity with which you are associated, are created to deal with the public and to accomplish good things for society. These organizations are likely to advertise their accomplishments, available services, merchandise, and successful projects. These organizations form your public spheres - that sphere which relates to all other people and which provides the economic relationships with which you build your security.

Management of Property (Tandem Estate)

In properly coordinating the activities of a tandem operation one principle must constantly be emphasized. You have heard it before and you will hear it again, and the reason it is repeated so often is that it is the most important principle involved in proper estate management. This principle is simply "each of your organizations is a separate, independent body apart from yourself and must be treated as such to maintain individual benefits." To be specific, you must not at any time confuse or commingle any of the property assets or transactions of the various elements of the tandem estate plan. Money in the corporate foundation bank account must never be used to pay for repairs on property owned and used solely by the trust.
