QUESTION AND ANSWER #4

I JUST CAN'T SEE HOW MY WORK AND BACKGROUND CAN POSSIBLY QUALIFY ME FOR ALL THESE BENEFITS.

At first it sometimes seems difficult to see just how one's activities would make it possible to gain the benefits that are available. For the reason that foundations are created to do good work and are granted charters on the basis of benefiting mankind in general, experience has shown that there is no legitimate product or service that does not benefit mankind. Shall we take a little time to work out a purpose under which your activities might qualify?
