RISING TAXES: IS THERE AN END?

ISCALLY SPEAKING, this was the tax week that was: On Monday, President Johnson asked Congress to expand Social Security benefits by \$4.1 billion to be financed by increased payroll taxes.

On Tuesday, the President called for "a measure of sacrifice" to finance the nation's biggest budget. A 6 per cent surtax on present income taxes would help, he said.
