As might be expected, the Task Force has a diversity of opinion with respect to the administration's proposals to institute taxes on tickets and expenditures in certain foreign areas. In this report, we have avoided a systematic review of these measures or their effect on international cooperation as related to this program. Consequently, nothing said or unsaid in this report is intended to represent any departure from the views individual members may hold on this subject.

We wish to thank the 153 members of our 12 working parties and many other individuals, firms, organizations, and Government agencies who have helped us in our work.
