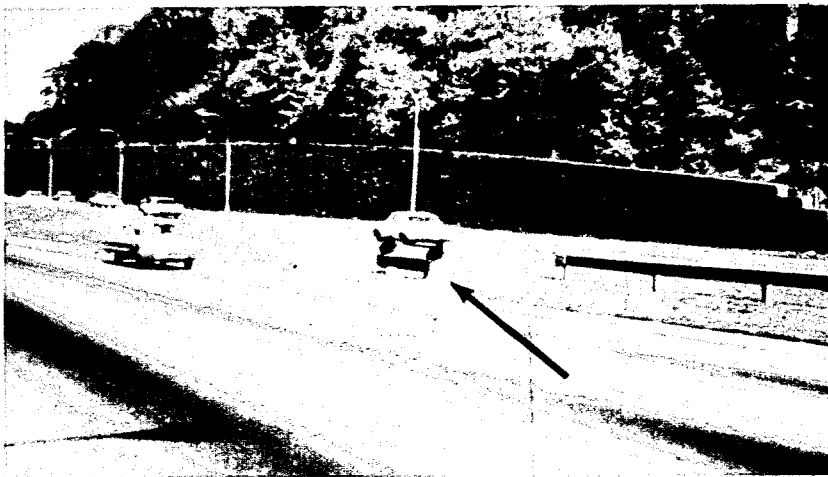


Mr. LINKO. That is right. They have to go around them.
