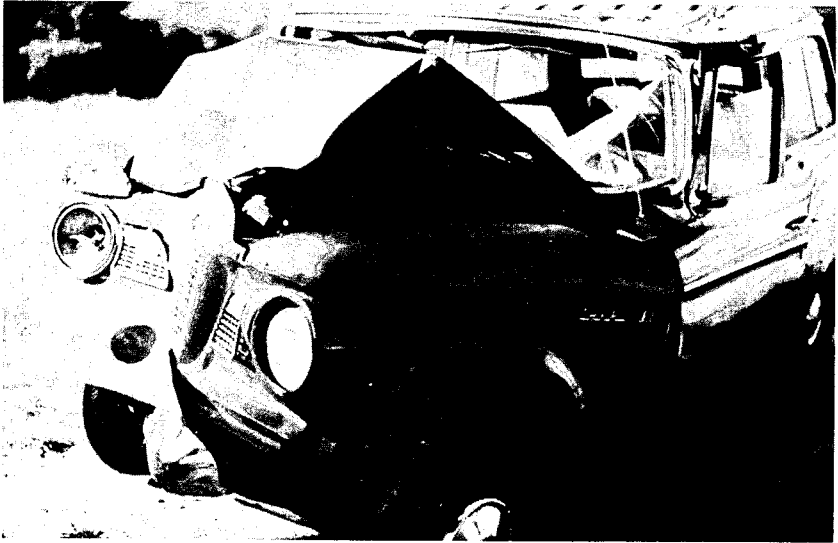


Mr. BLATNIK. Do you know what caused the automobile to go off the highway?
