

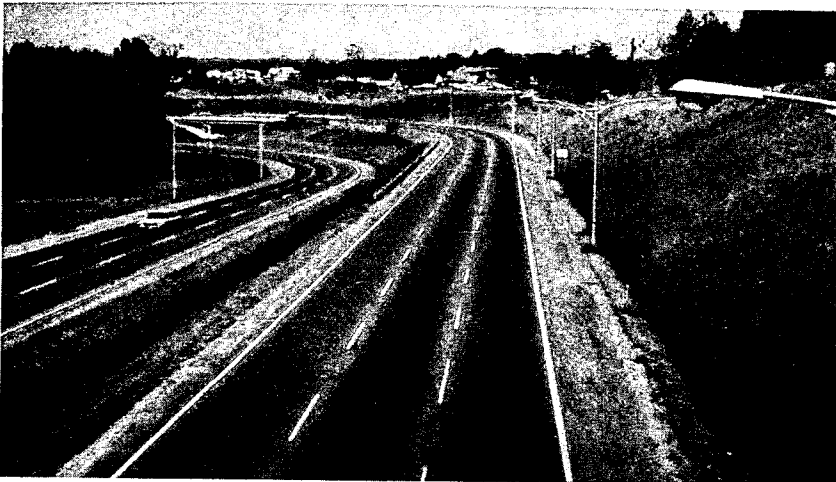
here is 70 miles an hour. The speed limit is 60 miles an hour. And here we have a sign with a recommended or advisory speed of 50 miles an hour, warning you of a curve ahead.

Notice the light pole just off the shoulder. The concrete piers in the median and on the shoulder are unprotected.

The next photograph is taken from the bridge at Greentree Road.

I want to give you a view of what is facing a motorist traveling in this direction. You will notice the light poles continuing on around the curve on 495. Over here in the median, small shrubs planted along here; guardrail not flared back, running toward and ending short of the curve.

The next photograph was taken about where this light pole is [indicating] in the curve.



Last year, in this stretch around the curve, there were 24 accidents and four more occurred just beyond this curve in that short stretch to Bradley Boulevard.
