This picture illustrates what happens when a vehicle hits that median. The bridge span had been up. It was lowered. The driver of the vehicle, the station wagon straddling the concrete median, was unable to get the vehicle in gear. The other traffic started to move, and along came the Volkswagen bus and the driver did not realize the first vehicle was stopped. The bus struck the rear of that vehicle, threw it across the concrete median, where it blocked the westbound lane. This

accident resulted in injury to four people.

This is one of the points I wanted to make. When you have an accident on the Woodrow Wilson Bridge, you can have as many as four to six to 10 cars involved in a collision, depending on the time of day, and you can also have a number of people injured, which accounts for the
