
Mr. Constandy. Thank you.
Mr. Prisk, could we get on to these slides?

Mr. Prisk. Yes. I think this discussion has been very helpful. Here again is the flared treatment that we have been talking about. This is another flare approach where you move from a cut section into an embankment area, simply an elaboration of the previous slide.



Now these are the types, or common "garden variety" of median barriers. The New York box beam, which has the relatively weak post and strong beam, there at the top, that box section, is one of the newer types. This takes a lot of the bending and these posts will drop as the car runs into that type of rail.
