
Here is a general view of the same installation, washers all the way through, and this looks pretty good. They have used 6-foot-3-inch spacing on posts.



Here, however, is one thing that we did find, that that 31 inches is up on top of a 6-inch curb for a good bit of the project, and compared to a standard American automobile, you will see that the top of the rail is fairly well up on the car, and I daresay that the possibility of getting into those posts might be a little greater. Just what would happen with respect to the curb in front of the rail on the rail's performance is a little hard to conjecture, but I do not think it would help it.
