The chart on the Interstate System shows the Bureau of Public Roads figures as obtained from the States. These figures show that for 46 States reporting there were 3,030 deaths on the Interstate System in 1966, and the combined average rate per hundred million vehicle-miles, which is the method of reporting, is 3.15 deaths per hundred million vehicle-miles of travel.

Of the total of all deaths on all of the highway systems, the Interstate accounted for 6 percent. Understandably, there is a substantial
