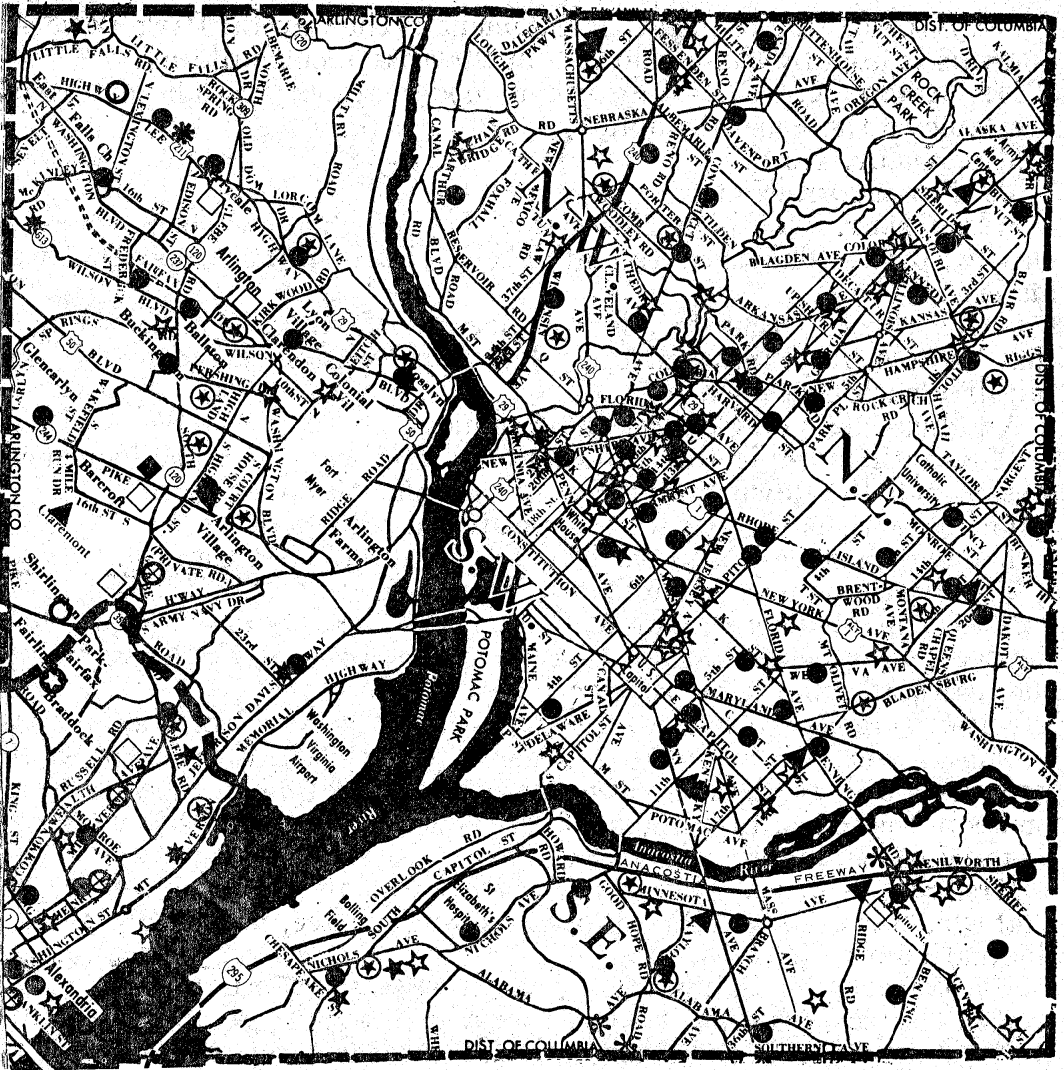




Mrs. KELLY. I can do that.
