wanted to know if they want to submit their statements for the record subject to the call of the Chair.

Mr. KUYKENDALL. This was my point. Submit the statement certainly, but I don't feel that with this important group that that is

ample testimony.

Mr. Pickle. Mr. Chairman, I would like to ask one of the witnesses whom I see in the audience, Mr. John Stephen of the ATA, if he would like to submit his statement now or await the time when we resume the hearings.

Mr. John E. Stephen (general counsel, Air Transport Association). Mr. Chairman, we have a statement we can submit. We are here at the pleasure of the committee. I would prefer to hold the statement until

we have the opportunity to answer questions.

Mr. FRIEDEL. Is Mr. Burnard here?

Mr. E. THOMAS BURNARD (executive vice president, Airport Operators Council). Mr. Chairman, I would like to do the same thing, if I may, please.

Mr. FRIEDEL. All right.

The meeting is adjourned subject to the call of the Chair. (Whereupon, at 11 a.m., the subcommittee adjourned, to reconvene subject to the call of the Chair.)
