Table 3 summarizes the components of family income for white military retirees. Wage and salary income constitutes the largest single component of family income in all but one of the comparisons for age groups under 65. Wage and salary incomes are generally lower for older retirees. Within an age group, they are higher for retirees with more school completed. Much of the variation in the wage and salary component of income is the result of variations in the number of weeks worked by retirees. Yariations in weekly wage and salary incomes of retirees are much smaller than variations in annual wage and salary incomes.
