Mr. CAREY. Secondly, I am interested in sort of a movement toward a uniform basis for student assistance among all students on equal terms. In this connection, we have not developed the effect of the 1967 recently passed GI grant system, GI bill benefit system, versus the ongoing systems under NDEA. If we examine the two plans of assistance, is it not true if a returning veteran with a family enters an institution, either graduate or undergraduate, he will get lesser benefit than an NDEA eligible recipient? Isn't the scale of benefits better for the returning GI?
