

LABOR FORCE ANALYST

This is technical work at the professional entry level in labor force analysis. An employee in this class usually receives supervision and assignments from the chief of reports and analysis, a higher level labor force analyst, local office manager, or area supervisor. Responsibilities include the collection, interpretation and presentation of economic and statistical data concerning labor force conditions in an assigned labor force area, and the preparation of reports on local office activities. The duties may entail supervision and training of local office personnel engaged in the collection, compilation and preparation of statistical data. This class usually requires college graduation including courses in statistics, economics, or business administration and some experience in the compilation and interpretation of statistical information, or equivalent combination of education and experience.
