

EMPLOYMENT COUNSELOR

This is specialized employment service work at the professional entry level of counseling. An employee in this class spends a major portion of his time in assisting applicants in making a suitable occupational choice or in adjusting to employment they have already chosen. The incumbent maintains cooperative relationship with schools and with health, rehabilitation and other agencies providing services that may be required to better fit job seekers for employment. In addition, the incumbent follows up on the adjustment of counseled applicants. This class usually requires college graduation, including courses in psychology, vocational education or counseling, personnel administration or sociology, or equivalent combination of education and experience and some experience in a closely related field.
