

DIRECTOR OF WELFARE RESEARCH AND STATISTICS

This is specialized technical and supervisory work which involves the direction of statistical reporting and analysis and research activities in a State Welfare Department. The incumbent usually receives general administrative direction from the Commissioner and consults with program directors. This class usually requires a Master's degree, preferably in the social sciences or social work, including or supplemented by twelve semester hours of statistics and social research methods, and considerable professional experience including the planning and conduct of social research activities in an organized unit, preferably in a social welfare agency.
