

MEDICAL SOCIAL WORK CONSULTANT

This is responsible professional social work in a State Welfare Department involving participation in the medical care aspects of public assistance programs and/or in the administration of APTD. An employee in this class usually works under general administrative direction. The incumbent assists in the development of policies, procedures, and methods for medical-social aspects of the public assistance programs, and carries responsibility for assuring that these established standards are maintained. The work includes responsibility, as a member of the medical team, for the social work role in reaching decisions with respect to eligibility. The incumbent participates in planned training of social work staff through interpretation of their responsibilities in the medical-social aspects of the public assistance programs. This class nearly always requires training in a graduate school of social work and some supervisory experience in social work with either training or experience in a medical setting.
