

CONSULTANT ON FOSTER CARE AND LICENSING

This is responsible professional work, usually under the administrative direction of the State Child Welfare Director. An employee in this class gives consultation to voluntary agencies and institutions, State agency child welfare staff, and other concerned individuals and agencies on the development and use of foster care services and facilities; program development and changes to meet the needs of children who need care away from their own homes either in foster family or group care; and interpretation to State Welfare Agency, voluntary agencies and institutions, State and local community planning groups, and other concerned individuals and organizations of standards and good practice. This class usually requires training in a graduate school of social work and considerable social work experience, including some supervision of casework with children.
