

CHILD WELFARE WORKER

This is professional social casework at the entry level but does not include the trainee. An employee in this class, after a brief orientation period, is expected to carry under rather close supervision a full case load helping children and their parents in situations where children have difficulties in family relationships, present behavior problems, have mental or physical handicaps, are neglected and abused, or need substitute care. This class usually requires training in a graduate school of social work, or college plus some casework experience. For workers without professional training, duties and responsibilities may be restricted and under closer supervision.
