

DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HEALTH STATISTICS

This is responsible technical and supervisory statistical and research work. An employee in this class organizes and directs the public health research and statistical program of the department. The work includes the direction of subordinates; assembling, tabulating, and analyzing statistical data; and the preparation of periodic and special reports with charts and explanatory data. The employee may supervise the vital statistics unit, but this position should not be considered the same as the vital statistics registrar or chief of vital statistics if these latter two positions do not include research. This class usually requires graduation from college with specialization in statistics and extensive experience in progressively responsible research and statistical work, usually in the field of public health.
