## DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HEALTH ENGINEERING

This is responsible administrative and technical work in planning and directing the state-wide public health engineering program. An employee in this class has responsibility for coordinating the sanitary engineering program as a part of a general state-wide public health program, and for providing technical engineering advice toward the solution and control of environmental sanitation problems. Supervision is exercised over a staff of engineers, technicians, and related personnel. This class usually requires a BS degree in engineering including undergraduate or graduate training in sanitary engineering, plus at least one year of graduate study leading to a Master of Science degree, or a Master's degree in public health and extensive public health engineering experience.
