

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE

This is the professional entry position in public health nursing. An employee in this class is expected to perform the scope of duties and responsibilities normally assigned a trained public health nurse. The employee works under only general supervision as regards the accurate performance of the technical duties of the position. This class usually requires graduation from an accredited school of nursing, State registration, and a program of study in public health nursing or appropriate public health nursing experience.
