

DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HEALTH EDUCATION

This is professional work of an administrative nature in public health education. An employee in this class directs a state-wide program of health education; supervises staff personnel such as district health educators, writers, artists, and librarians; consults with program chiefs within the agency on educational methods of achieving program goals; coordinates the health education program with other agencies' programs; consults with health educators and other personnel in local health agencies; mobilizes community resources for public health action; prepares and makes effective use of health education materials; plans and conducts in-service and community-wide training programs; directs conferences; recruits and places health educators, prepares budgets, etc. In some instances the work may include conducting research. This class usually requires a Master's degree in public health education and considerable experience in public health education or a closely related field.
