NUTRITION CONSULTANT

This is professional work at the consultant level in an agency having a nutrition director. An employee in this class is responsible for developing and carrying out public health nutrition services in an assigned geographical area. The incumbent works under administrative direction and with technical assistance. He consults with medical and para-medical personnel on current scientific findings in foods and nutrition and their application to agency programs; he may design, conduct or participate in dietary and nutrition studies or other studies with a nutrition component; he develops educational materials; and he cooperates with other agencies in the formulation and coordination of nutrition programs. This class usually requires graduation from college with a major in foods and nutrition, one year of graduate training in nutrition as applied to public health, and some experience in a health, welfare or related agency.
