

LABORATORY TECHNICIAN

This is the professional entry position in laboratory technical services. An employee in this class performs the more routine types of bacteriological, serological, chemical, microscopic or other analyses of water, sewage, industrial wastes, milk, dairy products, foods, and drugs. The incumbent may assist in special technical research projects. The work is performed under relatively close supervision and in accordance with well defined standards and procedures. This class usually requires no experience, but requires graduation from an accredited college with a Bachelor's degree in an appropriate science, such as bacteriology or chemistry.
