

PSYCHIATRIST

This is responsible professional and administrative work involving the direction of a local or regional mental health clinic. Duties include diagnosis and treatment of patients and may involve supervision and training of clinic personnel. This class requires an M.D. and a year's internship, usually supplemented by three or four years of specialized training and/or experience in the field of psychiatry.
