

VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION DIRECTOR

This is highly responsible administrative and supervisory work involving the direction of the state-wide program of vocational rehabilitation for the physically and mentally handicapped. This class usually requires an extensive background of experience in vocational rehabilitation work or designated related fields, including supervisory experience, and college graduation or equivalent additional experience.
