

VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION COUNSELOR

This is counseling work at professional entry level in the general rehabilitation agency. An employee in this class takes responsibility, under supervision, for initiating and carrying out rehabilitation processes for persons who are physically and mentally handicapped. The duties include the determination of eligibility, evaluation of individual needs and potentialities, and counseling of the disabled person in the attainment of a satisfactory vocational adjustment. This class usually requires college graduation and some experience in the field of vocational guidance, psychology, social work, personnel work or industrial relations, or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
