

TRAINING AND EDUCATION OFFICER

This is responsible professional work, involving the planning and administration of a state-wide civil defense training and education program. An employee in this class is responsible for coordination of local training programs with the State and national programs. This class usually requires college graduation, preferably including courses in education, psychology or public administration, and considerable experience in the administration of training programs including some supervisory experience, or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
