The Japan Monopoly Corporation has the sole right to produce manufactured tobacco. Only the corporation or an individual entrusted by the corporation can import leaf or manufactured tobacco. Leaf tobacco is imported chiefly to upgrade domestic leaf in their blends for the manufacture of their better quality American type blend cigarettes. When an individual imports manufactured tobacco for his personal use, with the corporation's permission, a duty of 355 percent (200 percent for cigars) is levied on the amount in excess of a certain quantity. The amount collected is close to the incidence in the case of manufactured tobacco imported and sold by the corporation.
