

1           (b) In the case of any such investigation, the Secretary shall  
2     give reasonable public notice thereof and afford reasonable  
3     opportunity for interested parties to submit views concerning  
4     the matters referred to in Section 2(a)(1), (2), and (3) of this Act.

5           (c) The Secretary shall promptly report his findings in any  
6     such investigation to the President, and shall cause a summary  
7     thereof to be published in the Federal Register.

8           (d) Upon receipt of a report from the Secretary containing a  
9     finding that any one of the criteria set forth in Section 2(a)(1), (2),  
10    and (3) of this Act is satisfied, the President shall promptly issue a  
11    proclamation limiting the total quantity of the article or articles which  
12    are the subject of the Secretary's finding which may be entered, or  
13    withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption in any calendar  
14    year to the average annual quantity entered, or withdrawn from  
15    warehouse, for consumption during the most recent three calendar  
16    years for which data are available. The proclamation shall limit  
17    the quantities of such article or articles which may be entered, or with-  
18    drawn from warehouse, for consumption during the balance of the  
19    calendar year in which the proclamation is issued to that propor-  
20    tionate per centum share of the average annual imports of such  
21    article or articles for the three-year period referred to in the pre-  
22    ceding sentence which the number of days remaining in the calendar  
23    year bears to the full year.
