(e) Subsequent to the first full calendar year during which his proclamation is effective, the President may by further proclamation increase or decrease the quantity of the article or articles which are the subject of such initial proclamation which may be entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption in each ensuing calendar year by an amount proportionate to the increase or decrease (if more than 5 per centum) in the total United States consumption of such article or articles during the preceding calendar year in comparison with the average annual consumption for the three-year period referred to in subsection (d) of this section, as found and reported by the Secretary. 11 The Secretary of Commerce, as to manufactured products, the Secretary of Agriculture, as to agricultural commodities and forestry products, and the Secretary of the Interior, as to mineral products and fishery products, shall determine and

allocate the allowable quantities of the article or articles which are the subject of a Presidential proclamation which may be entered, or withdrawn from warehouse, for consumption among supplying countries by category of product on the basis of the shares such countries supplied by category of product to the United States market during a representative period; PROVIDED, that the Secretary shall give due account to special factors which have affected or may affect the trade in any category of such products. The Secretary shall certify such allocations to the Secretary of the Treasury.
